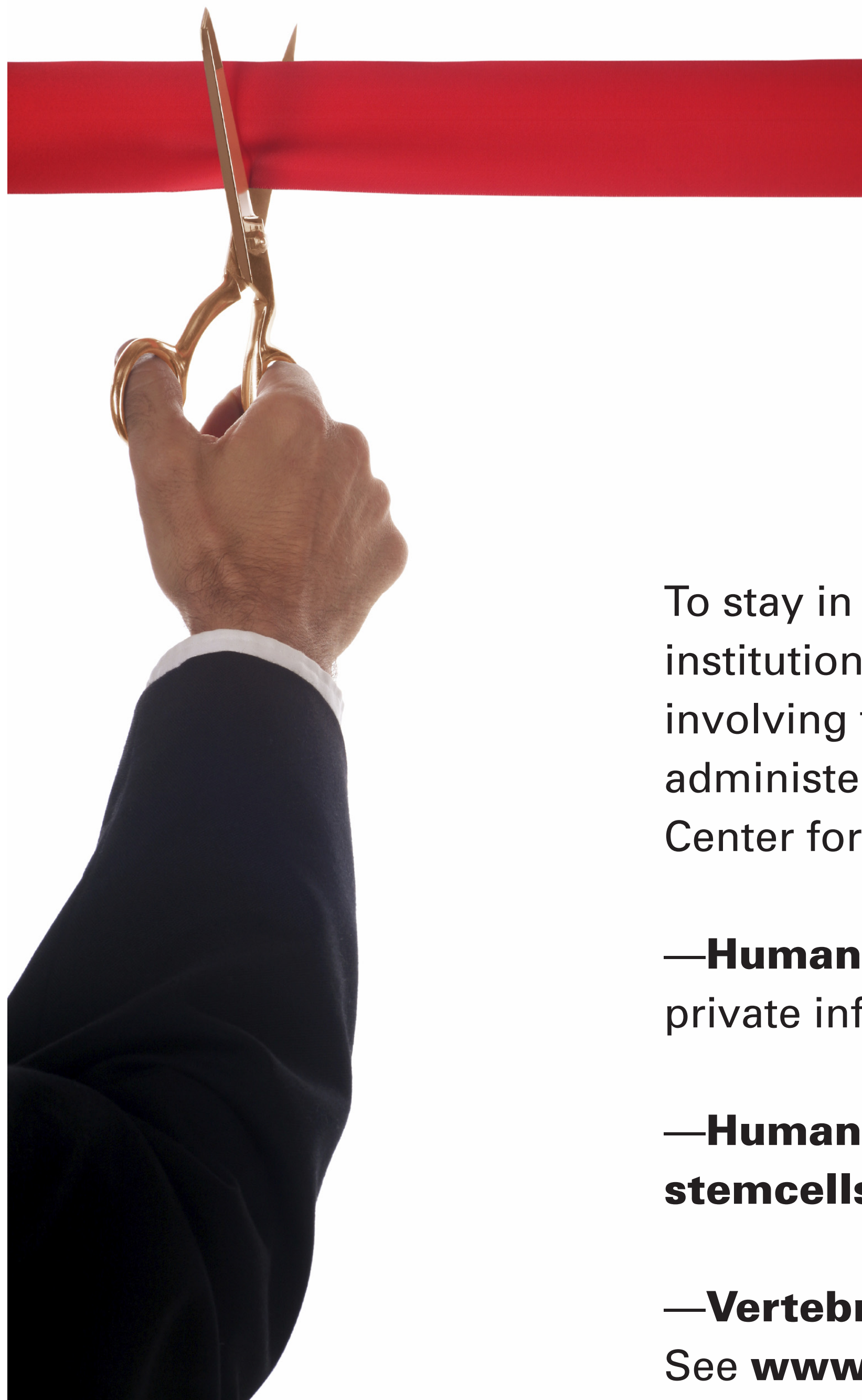

# R E S E A R C H C O M P L I A N C E S



**Who needs** more paperwork at grant proposal time? It seems like just so much more **red tape**. But getting your research compliances in order is **important to protect yourself, your students, your research subjects, and the university.**

**Why? Safety reasons. Ethical reasons. Legal reasons.**

To stay in the clear, all researchers need prior institutional approval for projects (**grant-funded or not!**) involving the following areas. Institutional review committees administered by ORDA oversee some compliances, and the Center for Environmental Health and Safety oversees others.

—**Human subjects**, including preexisting identifiable private information. See [www.orda.siu.edu/human](http://www.orda.siu.edu/human).

—**Human stem cells**. See [www.orda.siu.edu/compliances/stemcells.html](http://www.orda.siu.edu/compliances/stemcells.html). Multiple review committees are involved.
