FACULTY RESEARCH SUPPORT



A bit of financial help may be just what you need to get a research, scholarly, or creative project started—to collect or analyze pilot data, travel to a research site, or acquire needed supplies and equipment.

SIUC's **Faculty Seed Grant Program** is designed to do just that with competitive one-year grants of up to \$25,000. Priority is given to new tenure-track faculty; established faculty making a substantial change in research focus also are eligible. The application deadline, in fall semester, is announced on ORDA's web site and in materials sent to departments.

Other research support for faculty includes:

—a **Matching Funds Program**. Matching funds may be provided by the Vice Chancellor for Research for grant proposals submitted to competitive federal programs that require a match, or for any proposal where a matching fund commitment would substantially increase the project's chances of funding.

—a **Travel Support Program**. Funds support travel primarily to national/international meetings to give presentations, and to grant-making agencies to help secure funding for major projects. Travel costs must be shared by at least one other campus unit.
